

HOW TO GET TO AMBER AT BYTHESEA LODGE

Bythesea Road, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, BA14 8HR

From the M4.

Leave motorway at junction 17 and take A350 to Chippenham. Continue on the A350 to Melksham and then towards Trowbridge.

Take the A361 at the Semington bypass roundabout to Trowbridge for a mile and at the next roundabout take the first exit onto Hilperton Drive.

③ Bear left and at the roundabout take the second exit for a quarter of a mile.

At the next roundabout take the first exit onto the A361 Trowbridge Road.

At the next roundabout take the second exit onto the A361 County Way and within a quarter of a mile you get to another roundabout and take second exit again, still on County Way.

Move to the outside lane; go through the traffic lights by Tesco Supermarket to the next roundabout, through two sets of traffic lights on the roundabout and leave at the fourth exit onto Bythesea Road (just before another set of traffic lights).

Pass County Hall on your left and take the first exit on the mini roundabout. Bythesea Lodge is a 100 yards down on the left.

From Devizes

From the A342 in Devizes take the A361/Bath Road.

Continue on the A361 to Trowbridge for a mile and at the next roundabout take the first exit onto Hilperton Drive.

Follow directions from ③ above.

By train from London

Take the train from Paddington and alight at Trowbridge station.

On leaving the station (through the car park) turn left and then directly right into Bythesea Road. Bythesea Lodge is 200 yards down on the left.
